

Terms and Conditions

All Pet Model owners must read the Terms and Conditions below and confirm their understanding and agreement. A copy of the signed Terms and Conditions must be returned to us prior to attending your first booking.

1. Definitions

“Assignment” means any services requested by a Client in connection with any form of advertising, photography or public relations project.

“Booking Form” is the document the Client must sign to confirm an Assignment

“Client” means any third party individual, partnership, company or other organization or entity in which contracts with the Company with a view to procuring the services of the Model in respect of an assignment.

“Company” means PetLondon Models, a division of PetLondon Trading Ltd, registered no. 4819529

“Fee” means money owing from a Client for an assignment

“Guardian” means the legal owner or handler of the pet model

“Offer of Work” refers to an offer made to a pet model and their owner from the Company

“Pet Model” means a pet registered with PetLondon Models

“Term” means the duration of a pet models registration with PetLondon Models

2. Bookings

2.1 The Company shall act as the pet model’s agent and negotiate and conclude agreements with Clients for assignments.

2.2 The Guardian grants the Company the sole authority on behalf of the Pet Model to collect and receive all gross income arising out of any Assignment undertaken by the Pet Model during the Term and also after the expiry of the Term if the income arises or is linked to any Assignments negotiated by the Company during the Term.

3. The Guardian’s Obligations

3.1 Once an assignment has been agreed to (verbally or in writing) the Guardian along with the Pet Model agrees to attend the Assignment on the agreed date(s) and time(s)

3.2 The Guardian shall act in a professional manner on any assignments and shall ensure that the Pet Model is kept under control at all times

3.3 The Guardian shall ensure the Pet Model arrives for their assignment washed and well groomed.

3.4 The Guardian shall inform the Company of any significant changes to the Pet Model’s appearance, such as change in coat colour or teeth.

3.5. The Guardian confirms that the Pet Model has comprehensive pet insurance

3.6 The Guardian agrees to indemnify and keep fully indemnified at all times the Company from any actions, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, legal expenses, awards or damages howsoever arising directly or indirectly as a result of any behavioral issues, breach or non-performance by the Pet Model or their Guardian.

4. Payment for Assignments

4.1 Further to 2.3 above, the Company will collect all gross income arising from an assignment. The gross income will then be divided between the Company and the Pet Model (in proportions which will depend upon the Assignment). The Pet Model’s

proportion of this payment, hereinafter referred to as the Fee, will be sent to the Guardian by the Company by cheque within 5 days of when the Company received the gross income. All cheques will be made payable to the Guardian, not the Pet Model.

4.2 Any fee payable to the Client for an assignment will be agreed in writing prior to the Assignment being undertaken and will be agreed to by the Client signing a Booking Form.

4.3 If an Assignment is cancelled by the Client prior to its commencement and the Company does not receive any payment from the Client, the Model shall not be entitled to any Fee.

5. Guardian's Acknowledgement

5.1 The Guardian hereby acknowledges that the Company will display the Pet details on the petlondonmodels web-site and will act as an Agent in securing Assignments for them.

5.2 The Guardian hereby acknowledges that a registration fee is the only payment to be made to the Company during their registration period (if applicable). This registration fee is a payment which is equivalent to a reasonable cost estimate for the Company to create and maintain an online portfolio for the Pet Model

5.3 The Guardian confirms acceptance that his/her Pet Model photograph(s) and any data supplied will be posted on the Company's web-site

6. Termination

6.1 Without prejudice to any other remedy available to it the Company shall be entitled to terminate its Representation of the Model at any point during the Term with immediate effect, and to remove the Model from the Company web-site, should the Model breach any of his/her obligations within these Terms and Conditions.

6.2 The Guardian may choose to terminate the Pet Model's membership with the Company at any point during the Term but shall be required to complete any Assignments that are not yet completed. No registration fee shall be refundable if the Guardian terminates the Pet Model's membership.

7. General

7.1 No variation to these Terms and Conditions shall be binding unless agreed in writing and signed by both parties

7.2 If any clause or provision of these Terms and Conditions shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of law then the remaining terms shall not be affected and will remain in force.

7.3 Nothing in these Terms and Conditions shall be considered to constitute a partnership or joint venture between the parties

7.4 These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by the laws of England and subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts

PET MODEL GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING AN ASSIGNMENT

PLEASE ADHERE TO THESE SIMPLE RULES!

1. It is VERY IMPORTANT that you arrive at jobs and castings ON TIME.

2. Always try to limit the number of companions that you take with you to a shoot. Please remember studios only have a limited amount of space and too many extra people get in the way. There should be a maximum of 2 adults per dog.

3. If your dog is ill and cannot make it to a casting or job you MUST let us know immediately.

4. Please make sure the animal arrives looking good with clean and well groomed.

5. Take snacks/water/food along for your pet.

8. Please take along toys etc. to keep your dog occupied and also to gain his/her attention during the shoot.

9. Please remember it is each guardian's responsibility to look after his or her pet at a shoot. It is also their responsibility to ensure that they behave themselves properly as poor conduct could result in the loss of future contracts for our company.

10. Remember to bring poo bags and clean up after your dog
